

Basbados FAQs

What are the dates?

Friday 21st June - Sunday 23rd July. Arrival from 5pm on Friday and departure from site on Sunday by 3pm.

Where is the location?

What is the accommodation?

BYO! Tents, caravans, camper-vans and bivi bags are all welcome!

What are the costs of the weekend?

The weekend costs £10 (£50 for a family ticket, £10 for a day ticket, under 2s go free) to attend but food will not be provided. Food options will be available to buy throughout the weekend (see below).

Will food be available?

We will have food available throughout the weekend but this will all need to be paid for on site. We will be accepting card/contactless payments but no cash. Food is still to be firmed up for the weekend but we expect to have: Friday evening: a dinner option, Saturday breakfast: bacon butties, Saturday lunch: BYO, Saturday evening: a food van, Sunday breakfast: pastries, Sunday lunch: BBQ.

What will be provided for kids?

There will be no formal kids work planned for the weekend and parents/caregivers will be responsible for their children at all times. There will be child friendly activities dotted through the weekend as well as a craft station and toddler area with soft play available at all times for early morning wake ups!

Will there be teaching/a service?

There will not be seminars or specific teaching provided, instead the focus will be on having fun together and building community. However we will be gathering all together on Sunday morning for a short service. There will not be a Big Sunday at West Town Farm on the 23rd.

Can I come for part of the weekend

In this time where we are journeying through Big and Small Sundays, we would love to use this opportunity to gather everyone together, so we would encourage you to come to the whole weekend if you can. But we understand that summer is a busy time and that may not be possible. You're welcome to stay for just one night or come down for the day. Just let us know your timings!

What facilities will be on site?

Please be aware that the site will be fairly basic, we are setting up camp in a field! Portaloo's will be available onsite and we have at least one shower, but with 200+ people on site please be aware as with all good festivals that you may need to queue!

Will there be power on site?

Yes there will be limited power on site and some charging points will be available.

Where is the beach?

Strete Gate Beach is a 15 minute walk away (it takes longer walking back as it's on a steep hill!), parking will also be available near the beach. Please note the north end of Strete Gate is a nudist beach, turn right as you enter the beach to avoid entering this zone. Blackpool Sands and Slapton Sands are both 5 minute drives away.

Are there any shops/restaurants nearby?

There are two supermarkets - Lidl and Sainsbury's - within a 15 minute drive. Stokeley Farm Shop and Pollards Combe Farm are a 10 minute drive from the campsite. There is a pub in Strete called the King's Arms which is a 7 minute walk away and there is a kiosk on Strete Gate Beach serving drinks and snacks.

Are dogs welcome?

Yes! Dogs will be welcome on site, although they will need to be kept on a lead at all times. If you're planning on bringing your dog please do let us know.

Can people outside of St Basil's come?

Yes! Everyone is welcome to join. Please spread the invite to friends and family.

Do I have to join in with the activities?

All activities are optional and you're welcome to dip in and out of them throughout the weekend.
